This position is responsible for general hatchery husbandry operations, including incubation, water quality monitoring, mortality removals, various fish handling projects and spawning related activities. This is a broodstock specific site, however broodstock specific experience is not mandatory

Application Requirements:

- General knowledge of water quality monitoring in both recirculation and flow through technologies.
- Understanding and adherence to hatchery biosecurity, procedures, and protocols.
- Knowledge and experience with salmon hatchery operations would be an asset.
- RAS operating, and maintenance experience would be heavily preferred.
- Broodstock related knowledge would be beneficial but is not mandatory.

Position Details:

- This position is temporary and full time, operating on a 5 days on, 2 days off schedule (not camp-based), and working 40 hours per week. Possible overtime may be required depending on business needs.
